RACE COURSE – ON THE WATER – SAFTY GUIDANCE

IN THE CASE OF AN ACCIDENT OR INJURY

1. Call Coast Guard Station, Sand Key, VHF channel 16.
2. Identify your boat name, your sail number, your approximate location, and state that this is an emergency.
3. State the nature of the emergency; provide any possible useful information on the type of aid needed (wound, injury to bones, muscles, joints or sudden illness, consciousness, etc.) and if the injured person is in the water.
4. Give your best assessment of the seriousness of the injury or illness as either:
Non-Life Threatening or Life Threatening i.e., stoppage of breathing, severe bleeding, heart attack, spinal injury, heat stroke, etc.
5. Advise if transport is needed and stand by for further Coast Guard instructions.
6. **After contacting Coast Guard Station Sand Key, please advise PRO George Pennington, VHF channel 72* or cell (727) 580-5431 first and Race Chairman David Kresge, cell (813)-833-2285 second.**

*or VHF channel instructed at the beginning of that race event.
