2021 Gulf **Notice of SERIES** (NoS)

(Includes: Winter Regatta & Fall Regatta)

1. Rules:

- 1.1 The Series will consist of two regattas and they will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Series and the Notice of Race for the Regatta's, the NOR for the Regatta will govern.
- 1.3 Notice of Race for each respective Regatta will be available at www.yachtscoring.com

2. Eligibility & Entry:

- 2.1 Open to boats with a current valid WFPHRF rating certificate meeting the requirements of a WFPHRF Category 4 Regatta.
- 2.2 Anticipated classes are spinnaker, non-spinnaker, racer/cruiser and cruising class.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by registering at www.yachtscoring.com.
- 2.4 Competitors may compete in a single race, a single regatta or the entire series consisting of two regattas.

3. Classifications:

- 3.1 All entrants must have a valid PHRF rating obtained from www.westflorida.org on record with DBC Race Committee. Verification will be approved and displayed with that competitor's registration at Yacht Scoring. If you are awaiting your rating from WF PHRF you may be given provisional rating by Race Committee.

4. Fees:

- 3.1 Any single race date within any regatta, if registered by deadline: \$15.
- 3.2 Each regatta; Winter or Fall registration fee: \$30 for three (3) race dates.
- 3.3 Signing up for both Winter and Fall regatta would cost \$60 in total for six (6) race dates. Must register for each regatta independently.

5. Schedule:

- 5.1 DBC Gulf Series – Winter Regatta

- 5.2 DBC Gulf Series – Fall Regatta

September	9/11/21
October	10/23/21
November	11/20/21

6. Sailing Instructions:

- 6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at Yacht Scoring, the Official Notice Board.



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7. Venue:

7.1 The venue will be the Gulf of Mexico approximately one half (1/2) mile south of the Clearwater Pass Channel Market #1 and one (1) mile west of the shoreline of Sand Key County Park

8. Course:

8.1 The courses will be prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Scoring:

9.1 All races will be scored using Yacht Scoring.

9.2 Each race date will consist of one (1) race.

9.3 Two (2) race dates are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

9.4 Each regatta, consisting of 3 race dates will be scored as an individual regatta

9.5 If Race Committee cannot secure a vessel to serve as Signal, races for that race date may be cancelled. Race dates will not be made up.

10. Prizes:

10.1 Awards are given for first, second & third place per qualified class within that respective Winter Regatta or Fall Regatta.

11. Risk & Disclaimer of Liability:

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk. See RRS 3 (Decision to Race). The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damages, illness, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Competitor/Skipper is liable for the safety and behavior of their crew. Competitors will abide by all the rules, regulations and documents that will govern this Series including safety related measures required by any State emergency order(s) issued as a result of any healthcare orders by Federal, State, or Local Governments. **Competitors voluntarily assume the risks associated with communicable diseases including but not limited to the COVID-19** All county related guidelines, ordinances and information pertaining to COVID-19 can be found via the following link:
