

INSTRUCTIONS
for
THE CAPTAIN'S LAUNDRY RACE
Saturday, June 18'th, 2022

The object of the race is to go around all marks, while also gathering stray floating "Captain's Laundry".

The only rule of this race is SAFETY PREVAILS!

1. **Check in** Check in on the west porch of the clubhouse prior to launching your boat. Sign the waiver if you have not already done so and have your costume seen.
2. **Launch your vessel** and bombard your competitors with water, staying in front of the clubhouse area.
3. **Support Boat** There will be a support power boat on the water.
4. **Marks** There will be one yellow mark and one white mark.
5. **Mark Placement** A large white ball is just west of the floating dock and a yellow mark will be just off Union Street, between shore and the ICW.
6. **Start** Around 12:45, the support boat will give multiple blasts on an air horn meaning that you need to go back to shore. Bring your vessel out of the water and stand beside it. Once all are back on shore, a blue and white checkered flag will be waved from the floating dock denoting the start of the race.



7. **The Course** From the start, round the white inflated ball directly west of the floating dock with it on your left side. Proceed in a counter-clockwise fashion, rounding the southern yellow mark near Union St. before proceeding to the finish. Along the way, keep your eye out for the Captain's laundry.
8. **Laundry** There will be 7 pkg of laundry floating on the course. **When retrieving, pick up the laundry and the bucket anchoring it.**
9. **Blocking Competitors** You can attempt to thwart your competitors by blocking them with your vessel, squirting water at them, etc.
10. **Finish** Finish the race after rounding the course by going between the floating dock and the white ball west of it. **When crossing the finish, clearly call out your name and hold out any laundry you may have retrieved.**
11. **Winning** The winner is the first person having completed the course who has the most laundry. If more than one person has the same amount of laundry, the winner will be the competitor finishing first.
12. **Time Limit** The time limit to finish the race is 4pm.
13. **Retiring** Should you choose to return to shore before finishing the race, please go to the floating dock and inform them. For safety reasons they want to be sure that all who left shore also return to shore.
